





NURTURING INVENTORS AND ENTREPRENEURS

At Windermere Preparatory School, it's never too early to start changing the world. From the early stages, we train our students to brainstorm, develop and execute ideas with confidence. We equip them with the tools to make a difference in the business and STEAM landscape, now and in the future. After all, today's students are tomorrow's changemakers.



In partnership with Start Up Studio, Windermere Preparatory School offers an Entrepreneurial Studies Program that teaches business and entrepreneurship skills over the course of three years. The program aims to diversify traditional classroom education through experiential learning, enabling students to identify their strengths and discover the entrepreneur within. Our students dive into a hands-on curriculum that emphasizes "learning by doing" and constant collaboration. They are mentored by practicing entrepreneurs and solve problems for real businesses. In the program, students learn that failure is not a negative outcome, but a positive movement toward new breakthroughs.

STEAM EDUCATION AND MIT COLLABORATION

In a groundbreaking collaboration with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), Windermere Preparatory School has designed a series of in-school challenges at the intersection of several STEAM disciplines, including Bioengineering, Robotics, and Computer Science. Every year, our teachers and students participate in workshops with MIT academics, giving them an opportunity to learn directly from the world's leading STEAM institution.

COMPUTER SCIENCE PROGRAM

In today's tech-driven world, computer science skills are essential for success. Windermere Preparatory School offers a two-course program, including Introduction to Computer Science and International Baccalaureate Computer Science. Students may include IB Computer Science as a second Science course, in pursuit of a full International Baccalaureate Diploma. Students in this program are exposed to Computer Science Honors, Computer Science IB, Java Programming, Program Analysis, Data Structures, Operations, Algorithms, and Computational Thinking.

ROBOTICS

To complement the school's growing Computer Science program, Windermere Preparatory School has now expanded its scope into Robotics. Our course, based on the VEX Design System, will expose students to a variety of Robotic concepts including Object Manipulation, Mechanical Power Transmission, Drivetrain Design, Lifting Mechanisms, and Systems Integration.



Growing up in Kentucky, Jacob Doss comes from a family of Division I football players and coaches. As an outstanding high school quarterback, Jacob Doss led Lexington Catholic High School to a 38-5 record during his three seasons as a starter and carried the team to the guarterfinals of the state playoffs his senior season. Over the course of his high school career, Doss was named to the Commonwealth of Kentucky Elite 22 his senior year, earned All-State of Kentucky, and was named District Player of the Year. He went on to become a member of Coach Joe Glenn's first recruiting class at the University of Wyoming where he was a two-time Academic All- Conference player and lettered in 3 of his 4 seasons. After a career- ending injury during his senior season, Doss discovered his passion for coaching attending all the coaches meetings and contributing to offensive game plans. Utilizing his knowledge and expertise of the game, Coach Doss founded the Windermere Prep Football Program in 2009. Since its inception, the team has compiled an overall record of 43 wins and 16 losses. One of the program's most notable achievements is its 100% graduation rate, with 98% of those seniors attending college, several of whom have signed with football scholarships. Coach Doss has coached in several All Star games and Quarterback Camps.





Michah Kurtz has received many notable awards throughout his career. Most recently, he was named the 2016 National Strength Coach of the Year by the National Strength and Conditioning Association. GRADE 7


Weekend Meals:
